## ADDENDUM NO. 1

### **Ouestions**

Can you confirm whether Base Bid #1 and Base Bid #2 include:

- Assessment at closure in general accordance with the CT DEEP Sampling and Analytical Methods for Underground Storage Tank Closure, at <a href="https://portal.ct.gov/deep/underground-storage-tanks/ust-closure-sampling-and-analytical-methods">https://portal.ct.gov/deep/underground-storage-tanks/ust-closure-sampling-and-analytical-methods</a>
- 2. Preparation of a closure report by a licensed environmental professional,
- 3. 30-day advance notification to the DEEP of pending UST closure,
- 4. Notification to the DEEP after UST closure,
- 5. Town Fire Marshal permit?

#### **Answers**

- 1. Yes. Compliance with CT DEEP UST requirements is required.
- 2. The closure report does not need to be performed by a LEP.
- 3. Yes. A 30-day notification to DEEP is required. The contract start time can be adjusted to allow for the notification.
- 4. Yes. Notification to CT DEEP using EZFile is required. Please refer to regulatory compliance in the RFP.
- 5. Yes. Please see Regulatory Compliance in the RFP.
