**TOWN STAFF / PRESENTATION:** Mr. Capacchione was present to provide an overview. He noted a portion of the siphon chamber and lines are one-half filled with sand and also need repair from the end of Woodward Street to south of the railroad tressel. The sand material will need to be cleaned out.

New England Water Main will bring in large trucks that will perform a vacuum & collection procedure and will also remove and dispose of the material. Gravel and rock material will need

to be brought in and put down in and around the work site to prevent the trucks from sinking into the ground. This fill will remain in place as it is better than attempting to remove it.

The Town of Killingly is performing the site work. Erosion and Control measures will be put in place.
