V. Unfinished Business:

A. Application #23-1582: Ferrucci & Walicki (Eric Hansen Forester); Daniel & Karen Jackson – landowners) for jurisdictional ruling; notification of timber harvest (3652.65 board ft); 3 Hartford Pike; Map IDs 2646 & 2645, Alt ID 109-13 & 9, Rural Development Zone

**PRESENTATION / APPLICANT**: Eric Hansen was present to review application for applicant. He noted a primary issue of IWWC was the operation area located about 50 ft/100 ft away from the Quinebaug River. It was noted all such activity would be done by hand -- using no equipment.

**IWWC COMMENTS**: There was review of correspondence from USDA, dated January 16, 2024, regarding state-listed species potentially present on property located at 3 Hartford Pike. CT DEEP has identified a Natural Diversity Database Area along a section of Quinebaug River and land adjacent to it that overlaps this property. IWWC members have concerns regarding endangered species in this area as noted in USDA/DEEP correspondence.

It was highly recommended Mr. Hansen plan for inclusion fencing to protect Eastern Box Turtle and Wood Turtle.

IWWC highly recommended Mr. Hanse consult with a Biologist when developing a Forest Management Plan as this is required by DEEP and is missing as a submittal with this application.

It was noted the EQUIP program does not allow tree cutting between April 15 and August 15 to protect northern long-eared bats and nesting migratory birds. Cutting would need to be completed by April. Eric Hansen responded in that project will commence after November or late fall / early winter.
