Discussed buying compost; Byron doesn't want to split an order from the same place compost was purchased last season. Discussed a tree at the garden that needs to be removed; Allison will contact DPW. Discussed which year KCG started and will add a 10-year celebration to the agenda for March.
 - b. Grant Update – Discussed the miscommunication regarding the grant and how the issue regarding the grant was on staff's end. All the appropriate forms have been sent in to DEEP and we are waiting on a contract to be drafted.
 - c. Financials/Purchase Plan – Check from Byron/Logee's was received for the wreath fundraiser.
 - d. Bylaw and Application Revision – Discussed a change on the application; the signature location will be removed from the garden rules application so that the applicant can keep their copy of the rules. Carrie made a motion to table the bylaws discussion until March; seconded by Linda; passed 3-0.
