Minutes

- I. **CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 5:05 PM.
- II. **ROLL CALL:** Heather Goodier (Chair), Carrie Gravel (Co-Chair, via phone), Linda Mathes (Treasurer), Warren Hastings (citizen/gardener), Allison Brady (staff).
- III. **CITIZENS COMMENT:** None
- IV. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**
Linda made a motion to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from 06/07/2023. Carrie seconded; motion passed 3-0.
- V. **BUSINESS – (Review/Discussion/Action)**
 - a. **Open Garden Discussion:** Last month motions were made approving purchase of irrigation system supplies in the amount of \$75 and the purchase of piping/shade cloth in the amount of \$75. Discussion on updated costs of shade cloth and how a purchase over \$100 would get free shipping. Linda made an updated motion to spend up to \$250 on shade cloth, netting, pro mix seed starter, and tools (all from same website in order to get free shipping); Carrie seconded; motion passed 3-0. Some items being purchased will be submitted for grant reimbursement. Discussed ideas for benches in the Linda Walden memorial garden; up to \$275 in grant reimbursement funds are available; discussed possibility of stone bench. Discussed material options for the extended pavers/pathway. Upcoming projects to focus on are getting rid of the mint, the bench, the pathway, and moving plants to accommodate the rec center project. Discussed purchasing compost (with grant funds) in the spring.
 - b. **UGCG Grant:** Discussed keeping an updated binder for grant work hours specifically.
 - c. **Other –** Possibility of rain on the second Saturday workday, but still planning on it occurring. Will decide whether or not to cancel closer to Saturday.
