

**TOWN OF KILLINGLY
BOROUGH OF DANIELSON
TAX NOTICE**

All persons liable to pay taxes to the Town of Killingly, Borough of Danielson, CT. are hereby notified that I have a warrant to levy and collect taxes on the October 1, 2015 grand list.

Motor Vehicle taxes are due in full on JULY 1, 2016 Real Estate and Personal Property under \$100.00 are due in one installment on JULY 1, 2016 Real Estate and Personal Property taxes in excess of \$100.00 may be paid in quarterly installments of which the first quarterly installment becomes due and payable JULY 1, 2016, and becomes delinquent on AUGUST 2, 2016 the second October 1 2016, and becomes delinquent on November 2, 2016, the third January 1, 2017 and becomes delinquent on February 2, 2017 and the fourth April 1, 2017 and becomes delinquent on May 2, 2017. Please note the Borough of Danielson is not taxing motor vehicles this year due to new legislation capping motor vehicle taxes.

Sewer Use Bills can be paid in two installments, the first installment due July 1, 2016 and becomes delinquent on August 2, 2016. The second due January 1, 2017 and becomes delinquent on February 2, 2017

Interest will be charged at the rate of 1 ½% per month or a fraction of a month from the due date. Minimum interest charged is \$2.00. The returned check fee is \$20.00.

All motor vehicle taxes not paid are reported to the DMV and registrations will not be able to be obtained until these taxes are paid.

If you have received a tax bill from a Town that you did not reside in or garage your vehicle in as of October 1, 2015, contact the Tax Assessor to request a transfer to the correct Town/City of residency as of October 1, 2015.

Failure To Receive A Tax Bill Does Not Negate The Tax Or Interest Due.

I will be at the Town Hall, 172 Main St. Killingly to receive said taxes Monday, Wednesday, Thursday 8:00-5:00pm. Tuesday 8:00-6:00pm and Friday 8:00-Noon. Taxes may be paid by mail to the Killingly Tax Collector, 172 Main Street, Killingly, CT 06239. If a receipt is required, please send entire bill and enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope. Online payments can be made on our web-site at www.killinglyct.gov. Payments may also be dropped in our drop box located in the rear parking lot next to the handicap ramp.
