

- Section 8-23 goes on to say "The Commission may, at any time, prepare, amend and adopt plans for the redevelopment and improvement of districts or neighborhoods which, in its judgment, contain special problems or opportunities..."
- According to UCONN Clear's Land Use Academy "The Commission must prepare, adopt or amend a plan for the municipality, showing the Commission's recommendation for the most desirable use of the land for residential, recreational, commercial, industrial, conservation and other purposes and for the most desirable density of the population in the various parts of the municipality.

- V) Completed Seal of Approval






Status – the work is ongoing; however, we may have limitations due to obtaining and working with State and Federal Grant Programs, etc.



Education


The education section of the P.O.C.D. reflects the Killingly Board of Education Strategic Action Plan.

Currently, work is still being completed on the Killingly Memorial School project.






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
P.O.C.D. GOAL – Housing, in both quantity and quality, available for the full range of income levels, which would complement the positive natural and cultural characteristics of the Town.








NATURAL RESOURCES








Non-Transportation Infrastructure
