- V. Business Bonni motion to suspend the rules, Sharon second, all approved.
 - 1) Walktober at Cat Hollow Bridge recap 42 people attended the Walktober event. The event was a success with many walkers crossing over the Whetstone Bridge to the cistern and the south side of the Lucas dam.
 - 2) Killingly Trash Issue Donna reviewed the votes to see if the solid waste subcommittee should continue to research town-wide pickup. The commission discussed trash pickup town-wide. Donna submitted an article regarding global recycling issues.
 - 3) Signs & Kiosks and Brochures for Conservation areas Brochures are up at Chase Reservoir.
 - 4) Open Space Brochure In process. Donna and Sharon will continue to work on the brochure after the first of the year.
 - 5) **DEEP grant for Recreational Trails** Eric reported on two grants that were applied for in the amounts of \$395,800 and \$227,000. The \$395,800 grant is for Phase V an ½ mile continuation of the existing trail. The \$227,000 grant is for design work to design the trail from the end of Phase V to the Plainfield town line.
 - 6) Chase Reservoir Forest Management Plan Richard Fedor gave Donna a copy of a forest management plan and a report done by an intern. The Chase Reservoir Management Plan was approved by the council July 2005. The commission discussed having a forester perform a forest management plan. Eric and Donna will reach out to several foresters about writing a forest management plan to be completed by June. Eric will write a request and will distribute.
 - 7) Town Open Space / Inventory of Potential Properties for Open Space Preservation Letters should be sent to property owners of priority properties. Donna and Sharon will review the letter

- and revise after Thanksgiving. Staff will do more research and update addresses and owner information.
