PRESENTATION NORMAND THIBEAULT: Mr. Thibeault, Killingly Engineers, was present to ask the Commission for their input on a pending residential building project. The anticipated project is construction on a 12 acre site for twenty duplex buildings (40 units) utilizing a four phased approach.

Joseph Theroux, Certified Soil Scientist, has delineated this site. The proposed access point is an existing gravel driveway that will require excavation and wetlands would have to be filled. Mr. Thibeault asked IWWC for options related to wetland disturbances and noted he would offer mitigation trade-offs.

IWWC CONSENSUS: The Commission is not in a position to determine wetlands trade-off at this point without submittal of appropriate wetlands impact reports. These reports are usually submitted at the time of application. At such time reports are received, IWWC will specifically review wetland related activities.
