- Ī. Call to Order and Roll Call

 - 2018 Garden Year
 - i. 2018 Gardeners / Plots
 - 1. Gardener Applications need to be turned in. Jess will redo the Burdick application. Heather will turn hers in. Sharon e-mailed an application to Dennis and snail-mailed one to Nancy. Wayland got a \$20 donation from Dennis that will go to Friends of Assisi.
 - ii. Planting Day Recap May 20^{th.} The day was successful with good turnout. All beds are full. Jess planted #9 and Wayland planted the Black Pond bed. There is an extra frame that Wayland dragged out and would like to fill with soil. Only Meg and Nancy asked for plants. Jess said she bought 2 bottles of fertilizer and the group discussed whether gardeners should fertilize their own beds or if KCG should do it. Carrie will buy 2 bales of salt marsh hay from Virginia Keith. Sharon said that Nancy wants to

address the Virginia creeper that always invades her garden bed and that we should have a cleanup day to focus on the fence. There was discussion about how to make sure the water tank gets filled.

Sharon suggested making a compost area inside the fence, building a solar dehydrator, and putting out a midseason survey for the gardeners to fill out. Jess wants to put Linda's Garden on the next agenda and Carrie wants to talk about successive planting.
