Good Day Public Comment at Killingly Town Council,

My name is Dennis Marden, I work as a Facilities Manager for KeyBank in Connecticut. I wanted to bring this flooding issue we are experiencing to your attention. See attached picture showing the significant nature of this problem. In cold weather as we have of late, this pond will become a skating rink. I'm having our stormwater system checked by our maintenance partner to ensure that its functioning properly. In speaking with them they indicated that it's been inspected in the past and our line is clear, that the problem lies in the town stormwater system. This flooding is of great concern to us as it is in our primary vehicular travel lane. This parking lot is also shared with the church and food pantry. Many pedestrians are on foot in this area. This has the potential to become a liability for all of us. I have sent notifications a week or so ago to the town of Killingly via See Click Fix and to also to several e-mail addresses for the staff in the public works department. I identified these addresses on the town website. Can you please have the stormwater system that is connected to our property inspected to ensure that its functioning properly? Can you please contact me ASAP to let me know what the next steps will be?
